Confronting the challenges imposed by a lifetime of pain and disfigurement is just the beginning for most burn survivors.
They must also struggle to heal the emotional and psychological trauma that can be equally painful and overwhelming while re-entering their new life in society.



The Alberta Firefighter's Burn Camp for Children

Burn Camp is a week long camp held in August for our young burn survivors, aged 7-17, who have sustained a burn injury that required a skin graft or resulted in visible or psychological scarring.

Doctors, Nurses, OT/PT's and Firefighters donate their time as organizers, medical staff and mentors.

Campers come from all areas of Alberta, the Territories and Western Canada to experience a week of learning new skills in a safe yet challenging environment. Over 700 children have attended in the 30 years of the camp's existence.

Burn Camp, is a place where if only for one week, a young burn survivor can just be another kid.

The Alberta Firefighter's Burn Camp for Children is entirely dependent on the donations it receives through The Firefighters Burn Treatment Societies of Edmonton and Calgary, and is proud of the relationships that have been built with our donators. Burn Camp is run solely by volunteers. The funds donated go directly to cover the cost of camp; including the camper's flights, camp transportation and busing, facility rental, off site activities and room & board. There is absolutely no cost to the camper or their families to attend Burn Camp, but there is certainly a **huge** payoff.
